

NorthEast-Millerton Library Trustee Candidate

The NorthEast-Millerton Library Board of Trustees supports the Library staff in their work for the community. The responsibilities of the Board include development of policies and strategic plans, fundraising and financial development, public relations, and advocacy.

A Trustee must be willing to attend monthly meetings, as well as give their time to occasional fundraisers, Library programs, and continuing education.

A potential Trustee must be a resident of, owning property or employed in the Town of North East or the Village of Millerton. It is important for each Board member to:

- Be a team player and be able to treat your fellow Board members with respect even when you disagree.
- Have a strong awareness of community needs.
- Be willing to serve all members of the community; independent of an individual's social or financial wealth, ethnicity, race, gender, background, or abilities.

We encourage all members of the community who are interested in joining our Board to:

- Reach out to the Director or a Trustee to learn more about the Library.
- Attend a Board meeting to see how the Library Board works.
- Fill out and submit the questionnaire to the Library Director to formally declare your interest.

Even if we do not currently have an opening for a new Trustee, we encourage interested individuals to still submit an application. As vacancies arise, we will look to the pool of interested people to select from first.

When there is a vacancy, potential candidates will be interviewed by the Board and voted on to become a Trustee.
